The role: Forklift Driver / Beetroot Washing & Grading Line Operator

We are seeking a skilled Forklift Driver with a strong understanding of stock control to operate our beetroot washing and grading line. The successful candidate will be responsible for managing the flow of produce through the washing and grading process, ensuring stock is correctly managed and that all operations are carried out safely and efficiently. The ideal candidate should have a strong understanding of forklift and telehandler operations, farm experience and possess excellent attention to detail, and prioritise safety at all times. This is a fast-paced, busy environment with long working days sometimes required but a great opportunity to be part of a fantastic team.

Key Accountabilities

- Operate the washing and grading line, including start-up, monitoring, adjusting, and shutting down machinery
- Ensure crop is properly washed and graded according to size, quality, and other criteria
- Monitor and manage stock levels of crop, ensuring a consistent flow to the washing and grading line
- Inspect crop during processing to ensure they meet quality standards
- Loading and unloading of boxes and big bags
- Assist unloading during import season
- Assist in box movements between stores and around site
- Assist QC in maintaining stock record keeping on a daily basis
- Assist in all site forklift movements
- Box maintenance and repairs
- Maintain accurate records of inventory movement, including quantities and locations
- Comply with all Health & Safety requirements
